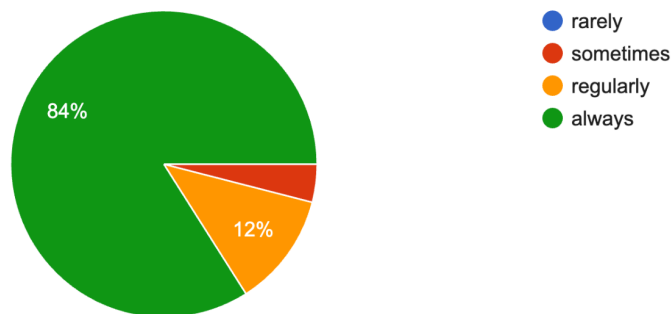


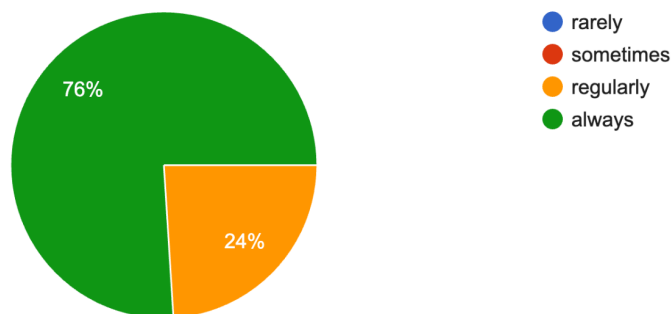
1. The Shafer staff recognizes that all parents, regardless of income, education, race or culture, are involved in their children's learning and want their children to do well in school.

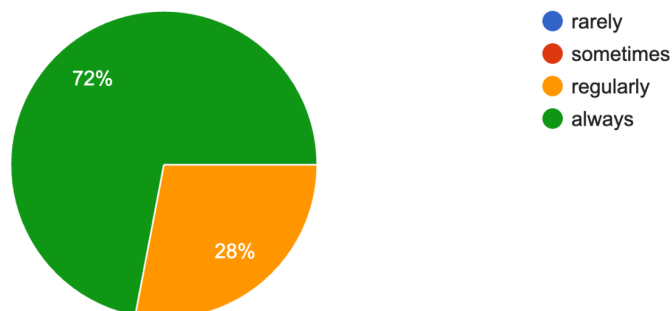
2. Shafer Elementary creates learning opportunities that will support families to guide their children's learning.

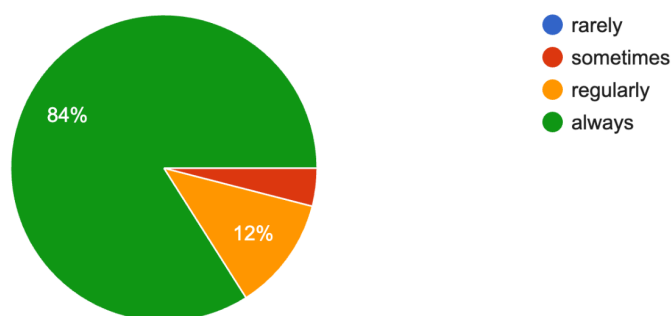
3. Shafer Elementary is willing to work with parents to build their engagement in our school.

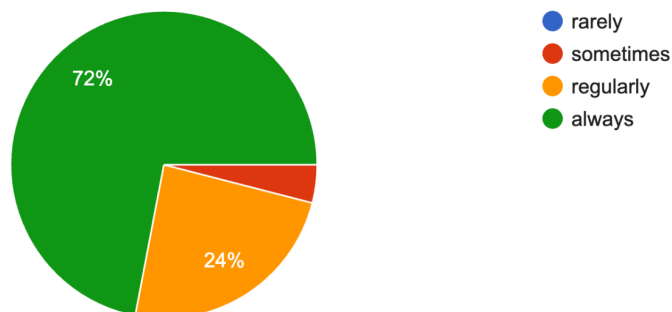
4. Shafer's principal has developed the capacity of school staff to work with families.

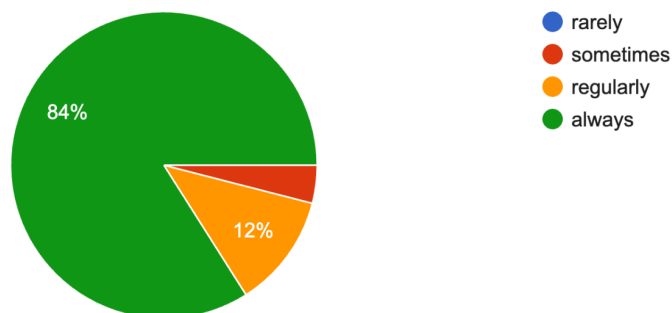
5. Shafer Elementary attempts to link family and school efforts to student learning.

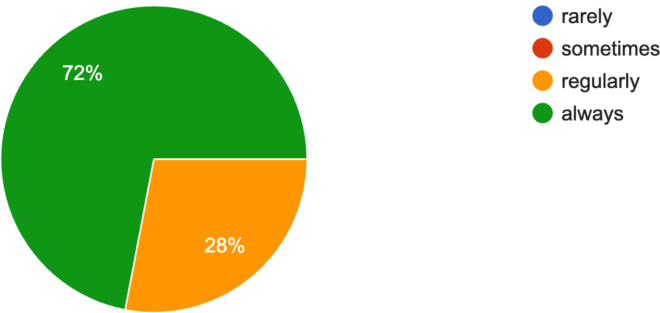

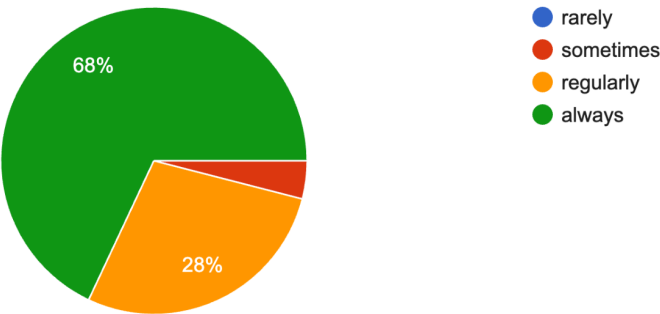

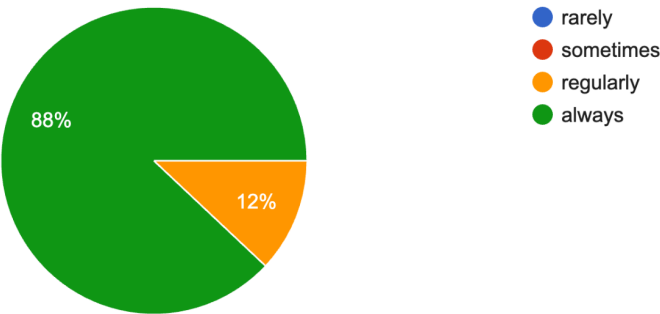

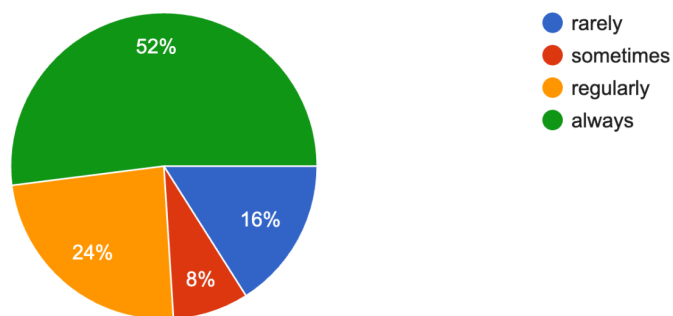
