Government & Citizenship

- Citizens form governments and work together to solve problems.
- A community is made up of different groups of people who live and work together.

Economics

- People use resources to meet their needs.
- People work together to produce, buy and sell products and services.
- There are many steps in manufacturing a product.
- People start communities near water, at places where people meet, or near resources.



Geography & History



- A community has a location on Earth.
- A community changes over time.
- Change in a community affects the people who live there and the environment.
- Communities have a history, including local communities.
- Technology plays an important role in the world marketplace.
