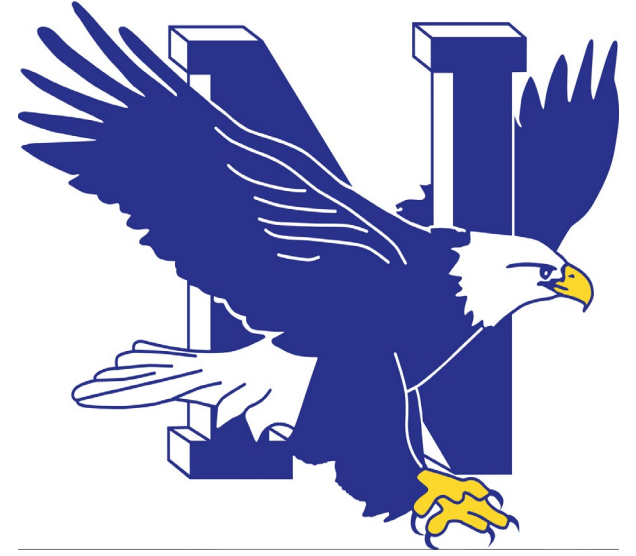

Moderate	10 to <100	OR	5% to <10%	Blended Learning Model OR Full Remote Learning Model
Substantial	≥100	OR	≥10%	Full Remote Learning Model

For ALL K-12 students electing to physically returning to school:

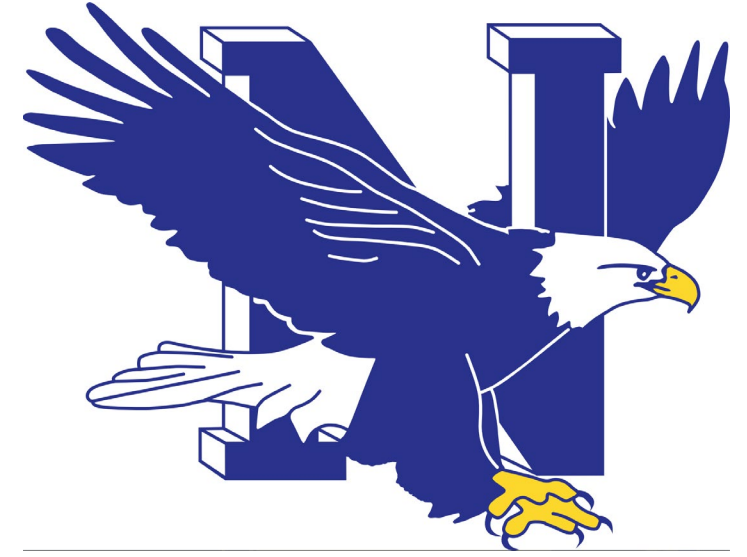
Monday: No Students, Office Hours for Teachers

Tuesday: A-K Students Report, Students L-Z Remain Home

Wednesday: L-Z Students Report, Students A-K Remain Home

Thursday: A-K Students Report, Students L-Z Remain Home

Friday: L-Z Students Report, Students A-K Remain Home



Recommended Blended Learning Model:

For ALL K-12 students electing to enroll in cyber:

Monday: No Students/No Instruction, Office Hours for Teachers

Tuesday: Full day of cyber instruction

Wednesday: Full day of cyber instruction

Thursday: Full day of cyber instruction

Friday: Full day of cyber instruction



Recommended Blended Learning Model:

Students attending CIT will continue to attend CIT every day. Transportation services will be provided for our CIT students every day. Transportation services will include specialized mid-day runs as needed.

Students with individualized education plans will attend school every day unless a modified plan is agreed to with the IEP team.



Recommended Blended Learning Model:

Lunch:

Lunch will be served to ALL K-12 students electing to physically returning to school:

At this time, it is the intent to serve lunches to ALL K-12 students electing to physically returning to school during their day at home AND for ALL K-12 students electing to enroll in cyber.

The following modified school day schedule will be utilized for the entire school year unless an alteration is required:

K-3: 8:30 – 2:15

4-6: 8:40 – 3:10

7-8: 7:45 – 2:15

9-12: 8:00 – 2:30

Recommended Blended Learning Model:

Modified start to the school year:

Cyber instruction will not take place from Monday, 8/31/20 through Friday 9/4/20. Cyber families/students will receive information in respect to picking up their technology hardware and other instruction materials. Pick-up will happen between 8/31/20 and 9/3/20.

Students physically attending school will receive their technology hardware while in attendance on 8/31/20 through 9/3/20.



Under the Blended Learning Model fall athletic programs and marching band will continue under the current guidelines that have been established.



Course schedules, teacher assignments, homeroom assignments will be delayed this year due to the on-going changes recommended to our school district. We ask for everyone's patience in respect to this matter.
