For ALL K-12 students electing to enroll in cyber:

Monday: No Students/No Instruction, Office Hours for Teachers

Tuesday: Full day of cyber instruction

Wednesday: Full day of cyber instruction

Thursday: Full day of cyber instruction

Friday: Full day of cyber instruction



Students attending CIT will continue to attend CIT every day. Transportation services will be provided for our CIT students every day. Transportation services will include specialized mid-day runs as needed.



Students with individualized education plans will attend school every day unless a modified plan is agreed to with the IEP team.

Lunch:

Lunch will be served to <u>ALL K-12 students electing to physically</u> returning to school:

At this time, it is the intent to serve lunches to <u>ALL</u> K-12 students electing to physically returning to school during their day at home AND for <u>ALL</u> K-12 students electing to enroll in cyber.

Students physically attending school will receive their technology hardware while in attendance on 8/31/20 through 9/3/20.



Under the Blended Learning Model fall athletic programs and marching band will continue under the current guidelines that have been established.
