

Adequate Yearly Progress (AYP) Targets (total of 70) met by all six schools for three consecutive years

College Board AP Honor Roll designation for 2011-12 and 2012-2013

Standardized Test Scores continue to increase

22% Increase in percentage of 2nd Grade Students meeting DIBELS End of Year Benchmarks (2010 to 2011) and continues to increase

7th Grade students scoring advanced on the Math PSSA 2011 – 71.4%; 2012 – 80.8%, increase of 9.4%! HS Math PSSA 2011 – 69.9%; 2012 – 76.1%, an increase of 6.2%!

8th Grade students scoring advanced on the Reading PSSA for 2012 is 73.0%



PROPERTY TAX REBATE PROGRAM

(AGES 65 OR OLDER)



- The Property Tax Rebate is based on the 2011-12 school district property taxes paid during the school year 2011-12. More information and forms are available on the District website @ www.nazarethasd.org
- To file for a Property Tax Rebate:
 - You must have <u>owned and occupied a residence</u> within the Nazareth Area School District during the 2011-12 school year and meet the following criteria:
 - O You or your spouse must have been at least 65 years old as of December 31, 2011.


or

O You were a widow or widower during all or part of 2011 and must have been 50 years or older as of December 31, 2011.

or

- You were permanently disabled during all or part of 2011, 18 years or older during 2011, and were unable to work because of a medical determined physical or mental disability.
- Your total 2011 household income, including your spouse's must have been \$35,000 or less. <u>Note</u>: Fifty percent (50%) of social security/railroad retirement income shall be excluded in determining income limits.
- Your 2011-12 School Real Estate Taxes must have been paid in full before March 10, 2012. You can NOT apply for the rebate if your 2011-2012 school real estate taxes were delinquent.

2013-2014 Budget Impact

Median Homestead Value for 2012-13: \$68,100, Increase of \$44 for the year.

Average Homestead Value for 2012-13: \$78,065, Increase of \$51 for the year.

A property assessed at \$100,000: Increase of \$65 for the year.

Overall Millage Increase: 0.65 = 1.34% (Act 1 Index = 2.0%)
