This Summer, we are partnering with **Vision To Learn** to provide free comprehensive eye exams. The results of a vision exam will indicate if your child is struggling to see clearly and if they may need prescription glasses. Good vision is important for your child to do well in school and in life. Choose an option below to help your child succeed!

## YOUR CHILD PARTICIPATES IN THE VISION TO LEARN PROGRAM

You can have your child participate in the Vision To Learn program. The routine eye exam and glasses are provided at no cost!

Here's how the program works:

1. The Vision To Learn mobile clinic is an eye doctor's office on wheels. It will visit us this summer

2. A licensed independent eye doctor will provide your child a routine eye exam. The results of the eye exam will be shared with you.

- 3. If needed, your child will pick out glasses frames.
- 4. Glasses will be delivered 3-4 weeks later.
- 5. If applicable, vision services provided will be billed to your child's Medicaid benefits.

## CONTINUE CARE WITH YOUR LOCAL EYECARE PROVIDER

If your child already has an eye doctor and you do not need vision services from Vision To Learn, please COMPLEE AND RETURN the consent form to OPT-OUT. We encourage you to return to your doctor for continued vision care services. To find an eye doctor near you, call the 1-800 number on the back of your child's insurance card. If your child has Medicaid, the eye exam and glasses are covered by your insurance!


If your child has received recent care from an eye doctor, and your child needs a pair of eyeglasses, then please provide a valid prescription (exam within 12 months) from your child's eye doctor or clinic to the Vision To Learn team BEFORE our scheduled visit.

Vision To Learn will help your child as follows:

- 1. Your child will choose a new frame
- 2. Vision To Learn will order new glasses with the prescription provided.
- 3. Glasses will be delivered in 3-4 weeks.
