	<p style="text-align: center;">714. PAPER RECYCLING</p> <p>1. Authority</p> <p>The Board shall provide a recycling bin for each district classroom and school office. Every student and staff member shall be required to dispose of paper products in the appropriate receptacle. Student organizations should be available to make posters and educate students on the use of the bins.</p> <p>The Board shall contract with a Solid Waste Authority for the disposal of paper products including newspaper and classroom paper. In addition, the Board shall, whenever possible, purchase recycled paper products.</p> <p>2. Guidelines</p> <p>Recycling bins shall consist of empty cardboard boxes from the Central Duplicating Center. Each elementary classroom and middle school homeroom may choose to decorate the boxes and enter a contest for the decorations sponsored by student organization.</p> <p>The student body shall be responsible for the collection of the recycled paper on a daily basis. In elementary schools, a student volunteer for each classroom shall be assigned on a weekly basis for paper recycling. The assignment of recycling in the middle school shall be a team responsibility with each team being assigned a certain portion of the school year. At the high school, a service club or the Student Council should be in charge of the set-up and maintenance of the recycling program.</p>
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
