# **BANGOR - PEN ARGYL - NAZARETH Adult Education**

## **INFORMATION**

**FREE** Adult Education classes of the Bangor, Pen Argyl, and Nazareth Adult Education program will begin in February 2020. The GED preparation class will help students improve computer skills, reading, writing and math skills to then advance to take the GED test. Students must attend class both days of the first week for assessment and orientation. If a student is not able to begin in February, they will have to wait until September or contact the Main Office at 610-332-8650 for year round classes.

The **Bangor** area GED preparation class will meet in the library of DeFranco Elementary School on Five Points Richmond Rd, Bangor from 6 pm to 8:30 pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays. The start date is Tuesday, February 4<sup>th</sup>.

The **Pen Argyl** area GED class will meet in the Pen Argyl Senior High School Library. This class will run from 6 pm to 8:30 pm on Mondays and Thursdays. The start date is Monday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>.

The **Nazareth** area GED class will meet in the lower level of the Nazareth Senior High School Library. The nights for the Nazareth classes are Tuesday and Thursday, from 6 to 8:30 pm. Class will begin Tuesday, February 4<sup>th</sup>.

The classes will run until the middle of May and new classes will begin again in September. The 37 year old program has helped many area students earn a GED. Students, who pass the GED, attend class and complete certain requirements, may receive an equivalency high school diploma.

The program is mostly funded by federal and state education grants managed by Northampton Community College. NCC operates one of Pennsylvania's largest Adult Literacy programs serving hundreds of students each year. Funding is also provided by Bangor, Pen Argyl and Nazareth school districts. In addition to these classes, information about job searching and continuing studies at NCC will be available.
